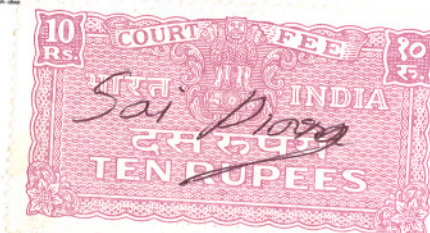

It is respectfully submitted as under :-

1. That respondent Wakf Board is owner of the land measuring 06 Kl 10 Mls as fully detailed in the headnote of the application and as entered in Jamabandi for the year 2005-06 of village Garhi Ajit Singh.
2. That the applicant took the abovesaid land on Patta from the respondent for the last more than 30 years and is in possession of the applicant, at the rate of Rs 3500/- per annum and paid the same upto 2006-07 and thereafter the same was increased to Rs 4000/- per annum, paid for the year 2007-08 at the revised rate of rent i.e. Rs 4000/- per annum. Latest receipt bearing No. 99128, Book No. C 992 for an amount of Rs 7500/- i.e. Rs 3500/- for the year 2006-07 and Rs 4000/- for the year 2007-08 is attached herewith. i.e. photocopy. Thereafter

the applicant requested the respondent board to receive the rent amount, manytimes, for the years 2008-09, 2009-2010 and 2010-2011, but the respondent flatly refused to receive the same with malafide intention to evict the applicant from the abovesaid land illegally.

3. That the land in question is situated within the territorial jurisdiction of ths hon'ble court, hence the hon'ble court has the jurisdiction to grant permission to the applicant to deposit arrears of rent as fully detailed in the headnote of the application.

4. It is, therefore, prayed that the applicant may kindly be permitted to deposit the amount of Rs 12,000/- as fully detailed in the headnote of the application, in the interest of justice.
