It is respectfully submitted as under :-

1. That the abovesaid appeal is pending before the court
of Sh. Birpal Singh, SDM/AC 1st Grade, Nawanshahr and the same
is fixed for hearing for 3.5.2010.
2. That the applicants/petitioners had submitted a complaint
before Sh. Gukkirat Kripal Singh, IAS, then Deputy Commission
Nawanshahr/SBS Nagar, as well as, other revenue authorities
who made endorsement on the complaint and directed Tehsildar,
Nawanshahr to send this mutation to SDM as contested mutation,
but the same was hurriedly decided by AC 2nd Grade despite



directions of then Deputy Commissioner, Nawanshahr and Deputy Commissioner ordered inquiry which was entrusted to Sh. Birpal Singh, SDM, Nawanshahr, who instead of recommending action against the concerned officer, dealt with inquiry in a casual way and without hearing the petitioner, justified the ~~act~~ act of AC 2nd Grade, which was illegal and without jurisdiction as AC 2nd Grade could not sanction a contested mutation.

SDM, Nawanshahr has already expressed his opinion and petitioners have genuine apprehension that they will not get even hand justice. Even or otherwise, respondents are openly declaring that as the earlier inquiry was decided in their favour, appeal will also meet the same way.

3. It is, therefore, prayed that the abovesaid mutation appeal may kindly be withdrawn from the court of Sh. Birpal Singh, SDM, Nawanshahr and entrusted to some other court of competent jurisdiction for decision, in the interest of justice.
